Inside the J-POP SUMMIT Travel Pavilion, guests will be able to immerse themselves in the virtual world of <u>"Japanimmersion"</u>, where you can see, feel, and learn all about Japan, as well as meet go-torch characters and regional mascot characters from multiple cities in Japan.
